Agastache scrophulariifolia



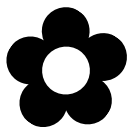
RUSTY PATCHED



- Highly fragrant foliage
- Blooms purple, July-October
- Declining in parts of its range
- Favorite of Endangered Rusty Patched Bumblebee

HELPFUL TIP: Requires habitat disturbance to persist in the landscape over time. Uprooting nearby competing plants can help.

COMPANIONS: Purple Coneflower, Bee Balm, Black-Eyed Susan, Foxglove, Beardtongue, Blazing Star, Phlox, Butterfly Weed, Little Bluestem, Asters

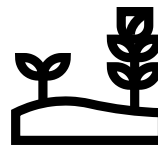
High Nectar Content
