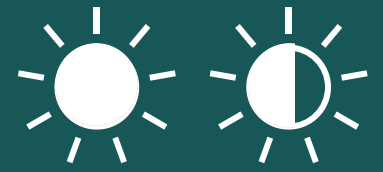

FACTS & LEGEND



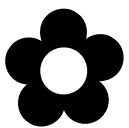
Arcadia

- Useful as hardy groundcover
- Blooms white, May-June
- Spreads voraciously in moist soil; more slowly in drier sites

### HELPFUL TIPS:

Easily propagated by divisions. Avoid windy sites. Stems may flop if located in exposed areas or in too much shade.

*COMPANIONS: Coreopsis, Yellow Coneflower, Solomon's Plume, Culver's Root, New England Aster, Boneset, Swamp Milkweed, Cup Plant, Stiff Goldenrod*

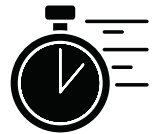
Attractive Foliage
