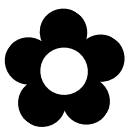
Arcadia

- Prefers part shade, moist soil
- Blooms white, July-Sept
- Very attractive to pollinators
- Dioecious; females plants form fluffy seed clusters

HELPFUL TIPS:

New spring growth comes from the previous years woody stems. Flowers abundantly, but blossoms are not fragrant.

COMPANIONS: Ironweed, Jewelweed, Fringed Loosestrife, Great Blue Lobelia, Boneset, Joe Pye, Swamp Milkweed, Northern Spicebush, Meadowsweet

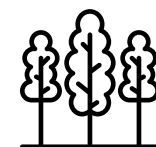
Clematis Clearwing Host
