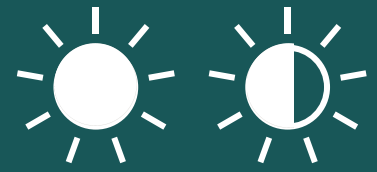

CLYMENE MOTH



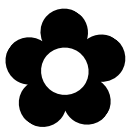
Arcadia
NATIVES

- Useful in a butterfly garden or woodland border
- Blooms blue, Sept-Oct
- Attracts pollinators in autumn
- Spreads by seeds & rhizomes

HELPFUL TIPS:

May not be suitable for small landscapes. Late to emerge in spring. Prefers part shade & soil that does not dry out.

COMPANIONS: White Snakeroot, Spotted Joe Pye, Boneset, Swamp Milkweed, Wrinkle-Leaf Goldenrod, Purple Stem Aster, Sensitive Fern, Indiangrass

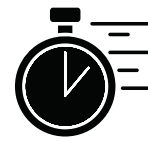
Deer Resistant
