

Rock Harlequin Corydalis sempervirens





- Attractive blue-green foliage
- Blooms pink, May-Sept
- Easy to propagate from seed
- Endangered/threatened in several states

HELPFUL TIPS:

Can disappear after a few years if competing with aggressive plants. Avoid very hot sites. Prefers cool soil.

COMPANIONS: White Pines, Columbine, Tall Thimbleweed, Bottlebrush Grass, Foxglove Beardtongue, Tall Meadow Rue, Bird's Foot Violet, Golden Alexanders
