MOTH

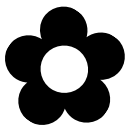


- Tolerates brief flooding

- Late to leaf out in spring
- Wetlands & rain gardens
- Pollinator favorite

FUN FACTS:

Can tolerate heavy pruning.
Pincushion-like summer flowers.
Fruiting heads can persist through winter & are eaten by waterfowl.

COMPANIONS: Shrubby St. John's Wort, Rose Milkweed, Elderberry, Royal Fern, Pagoda Dogwood, Hazelnut, American Cranberry Viburnum, Swamp Rose

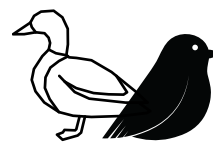
