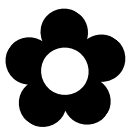
Arcadia

- Threatened in parts of its range
- Blooms pink, June-August
- Plumes of fragrant flowers
- Attractive deeply-cut foliage
- Produces pollen, no nectar

### HELPFUL TIPS:

Adaptable to drier soil with some shade. May overwhelm small landscapes. Intolerant of drought. Striking en masse.

*COMPANIONS: Meadowsweet, Obedient Plant, Cup Plant, Rose Milkweed, Blue Vervain, Joe Pye, Steeplebush, Ironweed, Blazing Star, New England Aster*

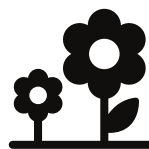
