


Smooth Rose Mallow

Arcadia NATIVES




- Fast growth in warm weather
- Blooms white-pink, July-Sept
- Flowers up to 5" in diameter
- Butterfly host plant
- Visited by hummingbirds

HELPFUL TIPS:

Useful as temporary privacy screen in summer. Dies back to the ground in winter. Useful in wet, soggy, or low lying areas.

COMPANIONS: Obedient Plant, Spotted St. John's Wort, Rose Milkweed, Cutleaf Coneflower, Ditch Stonecrop, Arrowhead, Blue Flag Iris, Monkeyflower, Lobelia


