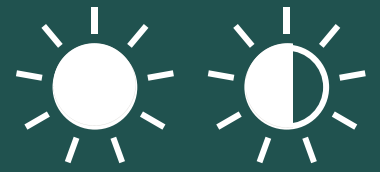

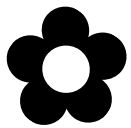


- Dainty, fine/thin foliage

- Often found in dry rocky outcrops or open woods

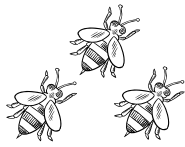
### HELPFUL TIPS:

Will not tolerate competition from taller or more aggressive plants. Easy to cultivate as a low-growing ground-cover in the landscape.

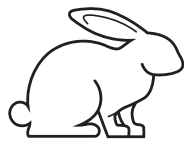
