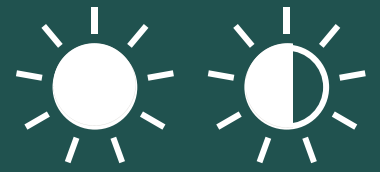

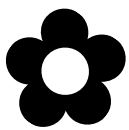


- Showy & colony-forming

- Thrives in wetland habitats; adaptable to garden landscapes
- AKA Harlequin Blue Flag

FUN FACTS:

Can grow in 2-4" of standing water directly in mucky soil or submerged containers. Rhizomes spread slowly.

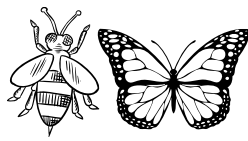
