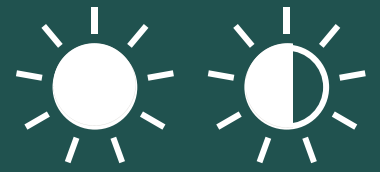

HOSTS WAVY-LINED EMERALD MOTH



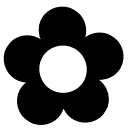
Arcadia
NATIVES

- Mixes well with native grasses
- Blooms purple, Aug-Oct
- Showy flowers attract pollinators
- Tolerates summer heat/humidity
- AKA Shaggy Blazing Star

HELPFUL TIPS:

Prefers full sun. Can become lanky in shade. Intolerant of wet soil in winter. May need staking in fertile loams.

COMPANIONS: *Little Bluestem, Rudbeckia, Prairie Dropseed, Goldenrod, Side-Oats Grama, Butterfly Milkweed, Indiangrass, Purple Coneflower, Aromatic Aster*

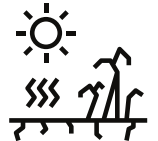
Seeds for Birds
