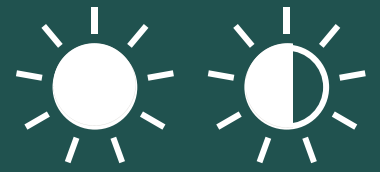

- Flowers best in full sun
- Blooms purple, Aug-Sept
- Thistle-like flowers to 1" across
- Tolerates shallow, dry, rocky soil
- AKA Savanna Blazing Star

HELPFUL TIPS:

Liatris benefits from deer & rabbit protection until well established. Attractive to Monarchs. May need staked.

COMPANIONS: *Big Bluestem, Whorled Milkweed, Showy Goldenrod, Calico Aster, Golden Alexanders, Hyssop-Leaf Boneset, Yellow Coneflower, Rudbeckia*
