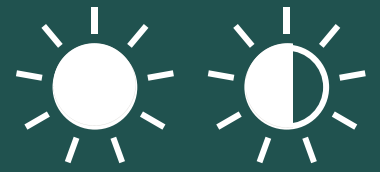


SHORT-LIVED PERENNIAL

CREATE A MICRO PRAIRIE



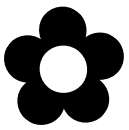
Arcadia NATIVES

- Delicate, wand-like stems
- Blooms pale blue, May-Aug
- Pollinated by small bees
- Self-seeds; colony-forming
- Highly adaptable

FUN FACTS:

Flower color varies from pale blue to nearly white. Tolerates drier soil than *L. siphilitica* & *L. cardinalis*. Native to open woods & prairies.

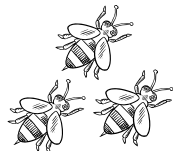

Mid-Late Summer



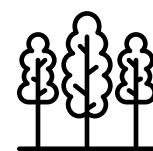
Deer Resistant
