


- Fast-spreading groundcover

- Maroon foliage in spring
- Wetland species; adaptable
- Host for specialist bees

FUN FACTS:

Shade & flood tolerant. May overwhelm small gardens. Macropis steironematis bees feed oils/pollen to their larvae.

COMPANIONS: Tall Meadow Rue, American Germander, Virgin's Bower Clematis, Honewort, Aniseroot, Golden Groundsel, Great Blue Lobelia, Hairy Wood Mint






