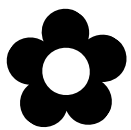
Arcadia

- Blooms white, April-June
- Tiny snowflake-like flowers are only 1/8" in diameter
- Picky about site conditions

FUN FACTS:

Seed capsules are like open cups & utilize splash dispersal. Impact from raindrops propel seeds far away from the parent plant!

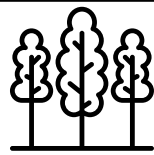

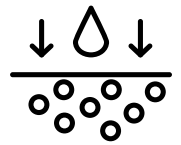
