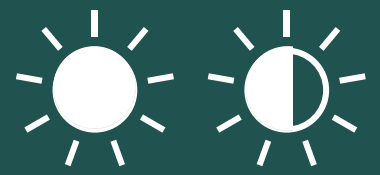

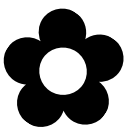


- Native to wetland habitats
- Blooms green/yellow, June-Sept
- Small, inconspicuous flowers
- Red seed capsules in autumn
- Useful around pond/rain garden

FUN FACTS:

Lacks succulent leaves like other stonecrops. Can grow in shallow standing water. Rhizomatous/stoloniferous.

COMPANIONS: Blue Flag Iris, Arrowhead, Bottle Gentian, Mountain Mint, Great Blue Lobelia, Pickerelweed, Lizard's Tail, Marsh Marigold, Rushes, Sensitive Fern

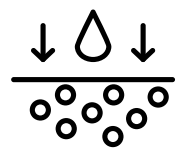
