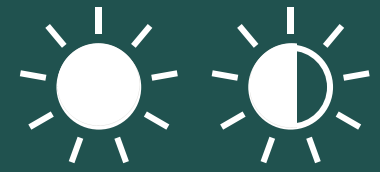

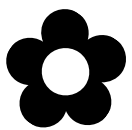


- Moist meadows & riverbanks
- Blooms purple, June-Aug
- Useful in butterfly gardens
- Protect from deer & rabbits
- AKA Wild Sweet William

HELPFUL TIPS:

Requires good drainage & a cool moist root zone. Prone to powdery mildew. Rarely found in the wild due to habitat loss.

COMPANIONS: Rose Milkweed, Marsh Blazing Star, Slender Mt. Mint, Brown-Eyed Susan, Wild Senna, Early Goldenrod, Blue Vervain, Smooth Blue Aster, Partridge Pea

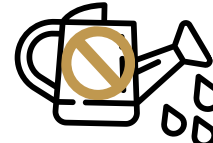
