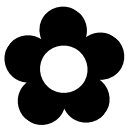


- Hardy, showy, & adaptable
- Blooms blue, June-Sept
- Tolerates sun with moist soil
- Mainly pollinated by bumble bees
- AKA Downy Skullcap

HELPFUL TIPS:

Spreads by seeds & rhizomes. Native to open woods, pinelands, & dry bluffs. Forms small colonies.

COMPANIONS: Early Goldenrod, Downy Wood Mint, Smooth Blue Aster, Anise Hyssop, Meadow Beauty, Tall Thimbleweed, Purple Coneflower, Lady Fern, Bowman's Root

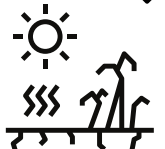
