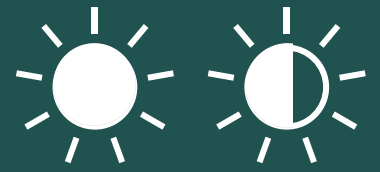


DECIDUOUS SHRUB

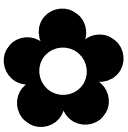


- Native to wetland habitats
- Blooms white, July-Sept
- Loose habit, colony-forming
- Tolerant of seasonal floods
- AKA White Meadowsweet

HELPFUL TIPS:

Yellow fall foliage. Prefers full sun. Sensitive to heat/drought. Young branches are green & become woody with age.

COMPANIONS: Summersweet, Joe Pye Weed, Swamp Rose, Rose Mallow, Queen of the Prairie, American Pussy Willow, New England Aster, Steeplebush, Winterberry Holly

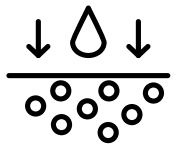
Spreads Slowly
