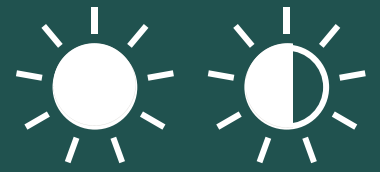

THE CARROT FAMILY



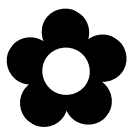
Arcadia
NATIVES

- Rocky woodlands, bluffs, prairies
- Blooms yellow, April-May
- Pollen & nectar for pollinators
- Host for Black Swallowtails
- Tolerates drier soil than Zizia aurea

FUN FACTS:

Heart-shaped basal leaves distinguish it from Zizia aurea. Persists by reseeding. Showy umbels attract pollinators.

COMPANIONS: Tall Thimbleweed, Little Bluestem, Foxglove Beardtongue, Prairie Dropseed, Meehan's Mint, Side-Oats Grama, Robin's Plantain, Violet Wood Sorrel



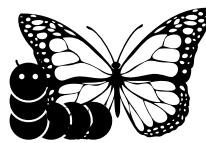
Late Spring

Attracts Pollinators



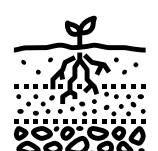
Swallowtail Host Plant
