

- Highly attractive to pollinators
- Blooms blue, July-Sept
- Candelabra-like flower spikes
- Tolerates temporary standing water
- AKA Swamp Verbena

HELPFUL TIPS:

Enjoys wet/mucky soil, but very adaptable to home gardens. Can be short-lived; self-seeds readily.

COMPANIONS: Joe Pye Weed, Tall Coreopsis, White Turtlehead, Cup Plant, Cardinal Flower, Boneset, Marsh Cinquefoil, Blue Flag Iris, Obedient Plant, Northern Sea Oats
