



- Ideal in prairies/dry open woods
- Blooms white in early summer
- Visited by flower flies/small bees
- Thimble-shaped seedheads
- AKA Long-Fruited Thimbleweed

HELPFUL TIPS:

Prefers dry open sites. May have trouble competing with taller, more aggressive plants in rich soil.




Deer/Rabbit Resistant




Dry Meadows
