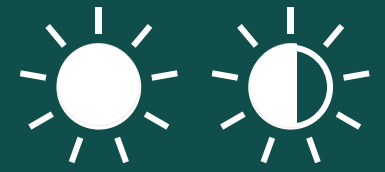

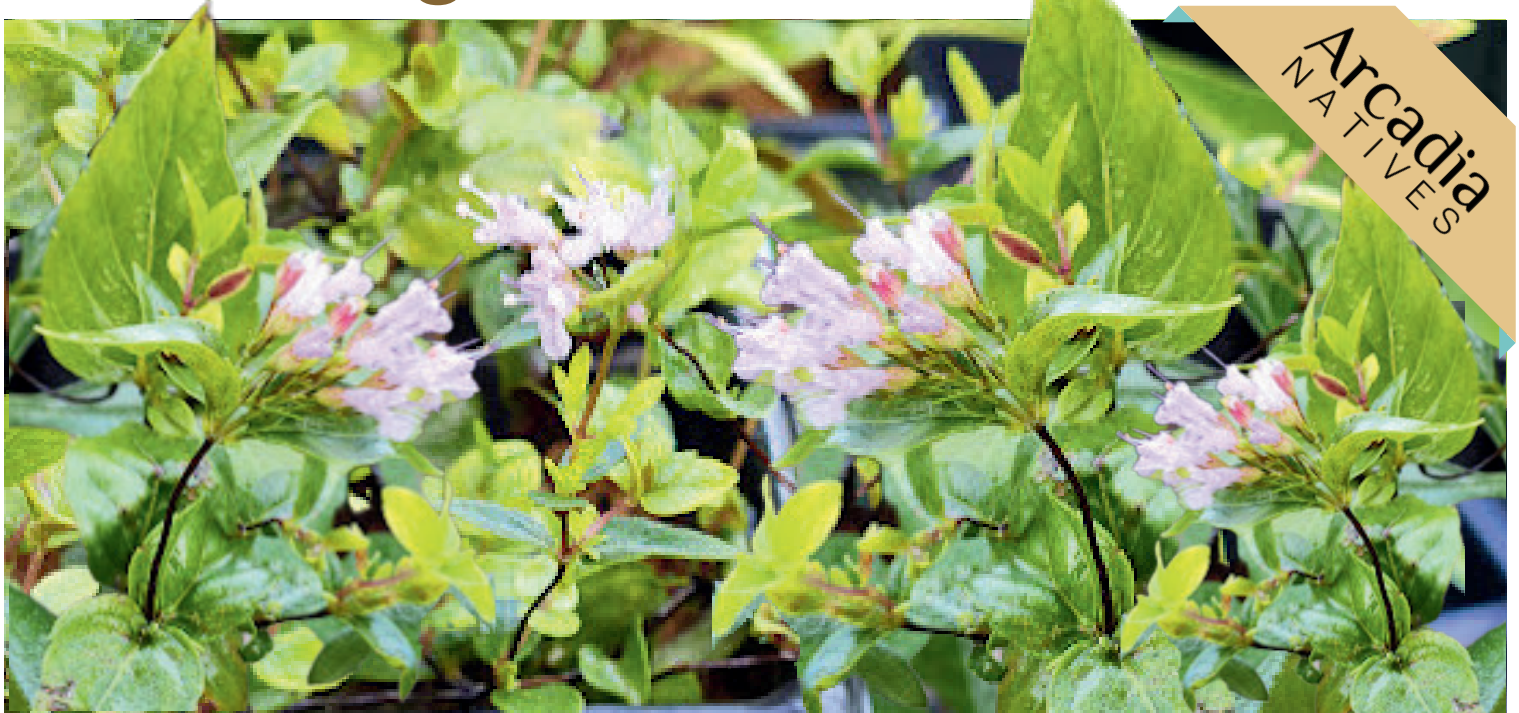
American Dittany

- Prefers part shade and dry soil
- Blooms lavender, summer -fall
- Fragrant foliage; mint family
- Associated with oak-hickory woodlands (sandstone soil)

FUN FACTS:

"Frost Flowers" may occur. Watery sap is pushed out of stem cracks into ribbon-like projections at the first frost.
