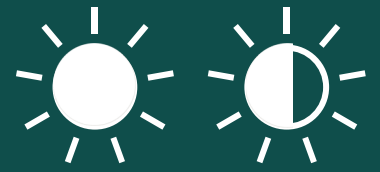

Oenothera fruticosa ssp. tetragona










SPECIALIST BEE GARDEN (PDF)



- Adaptable to various conditions
- Blooms yellow in mid-summer
- Evergreen basal foliage
- Leaves turn red in autumn
- Supports specialist bee species

FUN FACTS:
 Unlike some oenothera species, the flowers of this plant stay open in the daytime. Hummingbirds enjoy them!
