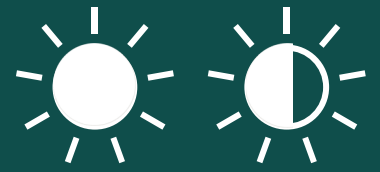

ECOREGION MAP



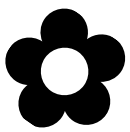
Arcadia

- Blooms pale blue in spring
- May not compete well with taller/more aggressive plants
- AKA Cancer Weed

### FUN FACTS:

A member of the mint family. Salvia comes from the Latin "salveo" meaning "to save or heal". Tolerates heat & humidity.

*COMPANIONS: Nodding Onion, Anise Hyssop, Gray Goldenrod, Winecups, Bitter Sneezeweed, Spotted Bee Balm, Pale Beardtongue, Stiff Aster, Butterfly Milkweed*
