NEONIC-FREE PLEDGE

Insects are an essential part of a balanced food web that includes birds and other wildlife. Neonic pesticides kill "pest" insects as well as beneficial ones. They are indiscriminate, stay with a plant for years, and cannot simply be washed off.

For that reason, no harmful neonics or any other systemic pesticide is used at the nursery. Arcadia Natives is committed to providing uncontaminated plants for pollinators & local wildlife to safely enjoy!

A "larval host" is a plant in a specific plant family that moths or butterflies will lay their eggs on. The larva (caterpillar) will consume just enough of the foliage to grow & thrive. You can best support local populations of lepidoptera by incorporating their host plants into your garden designs!

BUILD HEALTHY HABITAT

- **REDUCE LAWN:** Shrinking the lawn & adding diverse plantings helps to promote biodiversity & supports a healthier ecosystem!
- **ADD LAYERS:** Trees, shrubs, perennials, & groundcovers provide food & shelter for wildlife. Consider planning for a succession of bloom times.
- **PROVIDE HOST PLANTS:** Feed butterfly & moth larvae (caterpillars) by adding their specific host plants to your yard.
- **FOCUS ON KEYSTONE SPECIES:** Choosing keystone native plants can have a positive impact on pollinators, even in a small space!
- **AVOID PESTICIDES:** Broad-spectrum pesticides are indiscriminate. They may harm beneficial insects & wildlife that come into contact with them.
